The first 4 months of 2017 have been blessed abundantly of our loving Heavenly Father with over 150 souls receiving Christ as Saviour (it has been a very DRY season but "rain drops around us are falling" Amen?). Not only are we being blessed with SPIRITUAL rain but we have now entered into the rainy season of 2017 and there is lots of excitement in the air as gardens are being prepared and planted in hopes of a harvest this year as the last 2 seasons ended in disaster due to a drought.
