The first 4 months of 2017 have been blessed abundantly of our loving Heavenly Father with over 150 souls receiving Christ as Saviour (it has been a very DRY season but "rain drops around us are falling" Amen?). Not only are we being blessed with SPIRITUAL rain but we have now entered into the rainy season of 2017 and there is lots of excitement in the air as gardens are being prepared and planted in hopes of a harvest this year as the last 2 seasons ended in disaster due to a drought. The temporary bridge crossing the Bohoc River washed away and had to be reconstructed and as I write this newsletter (5/7/2017) we received another monsoon rain and am awaiting news that the temporary bridge is gone again. The construction on the road between Hiche and Saint Raphael starts again tomorrow so we are told. We just finished a Church leadership seminar taught by Dr. McCormick (my pastor) and Dr. King. Another wonderful celebration took place April 23rd, when my dear mother celebrated her 95th birthday. Thanks to all of you who have been faithful to pray for her. She continues to be in great health and when I can't remember anything (which is often) I call her as she has a memory that would startle most university graduates.

We will be Stateside the end of May through the middle of August before returning to Lapila and are looking forward to teaching again in the Mission Candidate School (we have 5 new candidates joining WFTWBM and another 4 or 5 families coming to check us out). Joyce and I would like to thank you all for your faithful support and prayers and personal involvement in us and the ministry. Without you, the faithful warriors, interceding for us we could not have accomplished what has been done and will yet be done for God's Glory. Come see us when you will.
